We invite you for a walk (rain or shine – it's fun!) for pre-design planning purposes on Reach 6 of The Glade (from below the beaver area down to Twin Branches Road as depicted on the attached map) on **Saturday, June 13, 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM**. We will meet at the basketball court above the beaver area as shown on the map.

This meeting is a walking trip with brambles and water; its primary purpose is to discuss and look at the staging area and access options. Based on the results of this meeting, WSSI staff will begin the design process and present a preliminary plan at future community meetings.

Since we will mostly be walking, we will provide a bag lunch, snacks, and drinks at the start of the meeting (that each person will carry) if you sign up by Wednesday, June 10. Please respond via e-mail (restoninfo@wetlandstudies.com) so that enough food and an adequate number of handouts are available and staff is on hand to help answer your questions.

Also enclosed with this letter is a revised meeting schedule for Reaches 5 and 6. Where as prior schedules were limited to the review of Reach 5 alone, we have added the review of Reach 6 at the same time – this process seemed to work very well for the review of Reaches 4A and 4B. Notice also that some of the dates for Reach 5 have changed from the previous schedule to facilitate the coordination with Reach 6. This latest schedule should remain in effect for the remainder of the project.
